California Surf Inc. is the real deal

Bobby Figueroa remembers 13 years ago, when he and other former touring band members from the Beach Boys first set foot in Port Charlotte.

The group, featuring original Beach Boy David Marks, played two shows at the old Reflections nightclub on U.S. 41. It was a sellout. That night spurred the idea that these musicians — all of them veterans of Beach Boys concerts and records — could offer something no other tribute band could.

"We have the distinction that we were there," Figueroa said recently via telephone. "Brian Wilson was a genius and he created the harmonies of the Beach Boys music from his heart and with his ear. The music sounds simple, but it's not."

Figueroa says the intricacies of the music and the harmonies that propelled the Beach Boys to 50 years of hits and successful concerts are difficult to replicate. But California Surf Inc. is as nearly as good as the originals and the still-touring, Mike Love-led product.

The band lands in Port Charlotte for one show only, 7 p.m. Feb. 5 at the Cultural Center. Figueroa, who plays drums and does vocals, is bringing along Matt Jardine, son of original Beach Boy Al Jardine, Billy Hinsche, Ed Carter and special guest Randall Kirsch, who still tours with the Beach Boys, who are taking a winter break. The members of the group have known each

other since touring with the Beach Boys in the '70s, '80s and '90s. All of them have gold records for their studio work on various Beach Boys albums and have appeared on stage with the group at its 25th anniversary TV special and in concerts at the Hollywood Bowl, Madison Square Garden and Carnegie Hall, among other venues.

Besides the Beach Boys tours, the group has performed on stage with the likes of Sir Elton John, Ringo Starr, Paul Simon, Billy Joel, Chicago and Ray Charles.

Figueroa got started as a 14-year-old in California, idolizing the Beach Boys and their music while he formed his own surf-rock band. Then, in 1974, he got a call from Dennis Wilson to audition for the Beach Boys.

"Dennis wanted to get out from more and was looking (for someone to play drums)," Figueroa said. "I showed up and auditioned and they said 'See you in Seattle tomorrow.' That was it."

The veteran musician cherishes his days touring with the Beach Boys and his relationship with Carl and Dennis Wilson, both of whom have passed away.

"Dennis brought me on, and it was Carl who first gave me a mike and allowed me to sing with the group. Dennis loved music and his family. He would have fought to the death for them, but he was living

a hard life."

Figueroa said he still keeps in touch with Mike Love and other Beach Boys and recently sang on stage in Detroit, Mich., during the 50th Anniversary Tour.

He promises that the Port Charlotte show will bring back great memories.

"People love this music because it is all about summer, girls, cars — it's non-threatening," he said. "And it crosses generations. The whole family loves it."

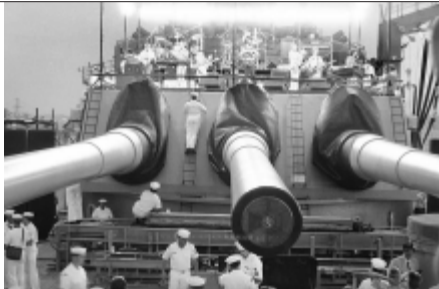

BACKLINE & RIDER

DURING ALL INTRODUCTIONS, AND IN ALL ADVERTISING, ETC. THE NAME OF THIS GROUP IS, AND SHOULD BE STATED AS: "CALIFORNIA SURF, INCORPORATED"

Please remember that in most cases, we require all sound / lights to be provided, and for fly dates require most backline to be provided. This includes 5 vocal mics on boom stands, as well as all necessary cables, pedals, guitar straps, etc. when the purchaser is providing backline. On some dates we can travel with guitars/bass as well as distortion pedals... please check with us on a show-by-show basis!

Please provide at load-in / sound check the following:

- * AT LEAST One (1) large case of bottled water (still, non-carbonated) - Arrowhead, Disani or comparable
- * 6 hand towels
- * One (1) package of HALLS Honey / lemon cough drops
- * Six (6) medium size white towels
- * snacks such as oatmeal raisin cookies / assorted muffins like blueberry, honey bran, etc. - thanks
- * In most cases, we also require a meal on the day of the show for the performers and staff (this is normally for 8)
- * dressing room / green room: please have an assortment of drinks (sodas, coffee, water, teas) available, and simple fruit and deli trays are always nice to have available before/during/after sound check. THANK YOU!

*** Please ensure we have all power cords, cables, guitar straps, stands, and keyboard & drum pedals ***

Note that on this show, it is normally 5 group members on stage, which each singing and playing an instrument.

GUITAR: (Christian Love)

- * (1) Fender Stratocaster (or Gibson les Paul)
- * distortion pedal for guitar
- * guitar strap, stand, cables, etc.

- * Any Fender amp... Twin, Deluxe, Hot Rod Deville
- * vocal mic with boom stand

DRUMS: (Bobby Figueroa) - please have a drum riser when available

- * please provide small floor fan for drummer
- * 2 rack toms
- * 1 snare
- * 2 crash (thin) high hats and a ride (Zildjian or Sabian)
- * 1 vocal mike w/ boom stand
- * Cymbals (Zildjian or Paiste) :: 2 crash cymbals
- * please have music stand available, if needed

- * 5 piece Drum Set . DW , Yamaha or equal quality .
- * 1 floor tom
- * All necessary hardware (stands , pedals , etc.)
- * 18 china boy if possible
- * 1 music stand if possible
- * 1 ride * 2 high hat cymbals

BASS: (Randell Kirsch)

- * (1) 4 string Fender Precision Bass (vintage model preferred, white if possible)
OR: If a Fender Precision is not available, a Fender Jazz (or Jazz/Precision hybrid) is OK
- * (2) Eden 4x10 cabinets (or comparable)
- * (1) guitar tuner
- * (2) 20' guitar cables
- * (1) vocal mic with boom stand
- * (1) Eden World Tour 800 Bass Head (or comparable)
OR: (1) Ampeg SVT and cabinet
- * (1) guitar stand

GUITAR: (Ed Carter)

- * (1) Fender Stratocaster (or Gibson les Paul)
- * distortion pedal for guitar
- * guitar strap, stand, cables, etc.

- * Any Fender amp... Twin, Deluxe, Hot Rod Deville
- * vocal mic with boom stand

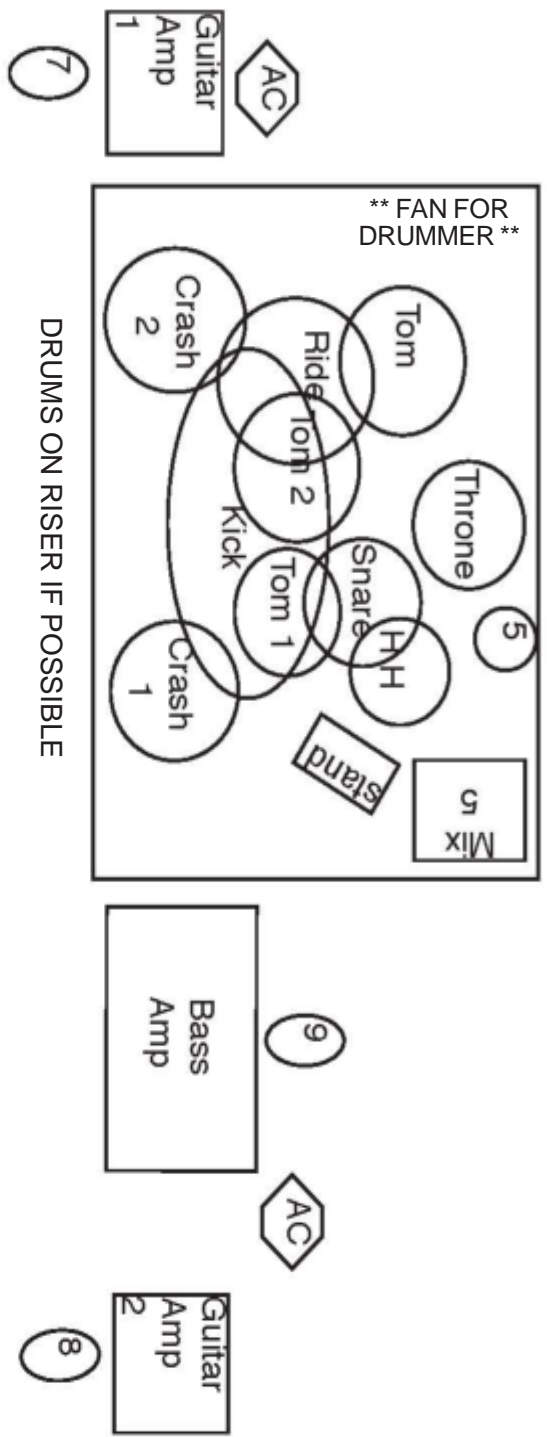
KEYBOARDS: (Sterling Smith)

- * One (1) Roland RD 500, 600, 700 or comparable keyboard with 88 "weighted" keys (must have ORGAN sound function)
- * Accompanying sustain (damper) pedal
- * vocal mic with boom stand

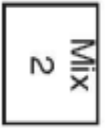
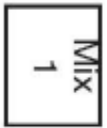
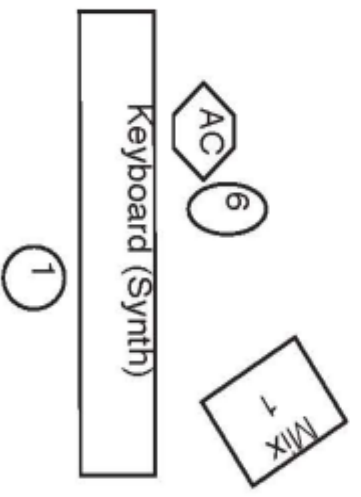

Stage Plot February 2016

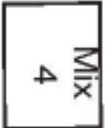
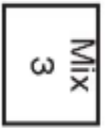
